### Are you the caregiver of a child between the ages of 11-16 months old?

#### You May Be Eligible If You

- Have a phone capable of receiving and responding to text messages.

#### And You Have a Child Who

- Is 11-16 months old.

#### Participation Involves

- Completing surveys about your child's development at two to four time-points within a 6-to-12-month period.
- Responding to brief text messages about your child's development.
- Receiving a one-hour telehealth evaluation that examines your child's social development at 18 or 24 months old.

**You can participate in this study from anywhere in the United States!**

All study activities will take place on a mobile device or computer.

#### Potential Benefits

- You can earn up to **\$125** for participating.
- You will receive tailored advice to support your child's development.
- Your child will receive a social development assessment and report from a licensed clinical psychologist.
